

Pietà means – Painful Mother

This sculpture represents Jesus dead in the arm of the Virgin Mary.

 Is the only one with Michelangelo signature because of his youth many did not believe he was the author On May 21, 1972, an Australian geologist struck a statue with a hammer. With a few strokes, he broke Mary's left hand and a piece of her nose and eyelid. The statue is protected by a glass wall that has been unbreakable since its restoration.
