

The Valladolid debate

This famous Spanish debate took place from 1550–1551 — prime time for the Spanish wars of conquest in the New World. It concerned a theologically and politically pressing issue of the time: did the native peoples of the Americas deserve the same treatment as free men? Or did Christian teachings and natural law make colonization (and thus oppression) imperative?

The Lincoln-Douglas Debates "Great Debates of 1858"



Between August 21st and October 15th in 1858, Abraham Lincoln and Stephen Douglas engaged in a series of seven debates focusing on the controversial subject of slavery in the United States.

Kennedy versus Nixon, 1960

The first televised American presidential debate took place on 26 September 1960 between Republican vice-president Richard Nixon, and Democrat John F Kennedy.
